Data subjects: users of the reserved area/registered users

In accordance with Articles 13 and 14 of European Regulation 2016/679, we inform you that PA SPA, with registered office in Via Milano, 13 - 42048, Rubiera (RE), Italia, +39 0522 623612, as Data Controller, processes your data name, company, country, telephone, e-mail to allow you access to the reserved area, which will allow you to access the services provided within the area dedicated to you. The provision of data for these purposes is the fulfilment of your request. The legal basis for the processing is Article 6.1.b) of the GDPR.

Your personal data will be processed manually, electronically and/or telematically, through the use of cookies (as indicated in the cookie policy available on the website) and by means of electronic computers using third-party software in accordance with the procedures set out in Articles 6 and 32 of the GDPR and through the adoption of the appropriate security measures provided for.

Your data will be processed by appropriately appointed personnel and will be communicated externally to companies acting as independent Data Controllers or Data Processors:

- external parties providing cloud services;
- technical support service providers;
- group companies providing IT system management services, including server hosting and backup services;
- within the scope of public and/or private entities for which the communication of data is mandatory or necessary in compliance with legal obligations or is in any case functional to the administration of the relationship. Your data may also be viewed by the company that manages the website, limited to technical access for maintenance and web server management purposes.

Your data will not be disclosed.

For technical and/or organisational reasons, your data is transferred to countries belonging to the European Union: this transfer is in any case legitimate as it is guaranteed by the existence of adequacy decisions issued by the European Commission and/or standard protection clauses based on the models adopted by the European Commission pursuant to Article 46 of the GDPR.

You may request from the Data Controller a copy of the safeguards adopted for the transfer of your personal data to the EU, as well as information on the locations where they have been made available, by sending a specific request to the Data Controller via email at privacy@pa-etl.it.

Please note that, in accordance with the principles of lawfulness, purpose limitation and data minimisation, pursuant to Article 5 of the GDPR, your data will be stored for the time necessary to provide the service you have requested.

EU Regulation 2016/679: Articles 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22 - Rights of the Data Subject

1. The data subject has the right to obtain confirmation of the existence or otherwise of personal data concerning him/her, even if not yet recorded, and

their communication in intelligible form and the possibility of lodging a complaint with the Supervisory Authority

2. The data subject has the right to obtain information on:

- a) the origin of the personal data;
- b) the purposes and methods of processing;
- c) the logic applied in the case of processing carried out with the aid of electronic instruments;
- d) the identification details of the data controller, data processors and designated representative pursuant to Article 5, paragraph 2;
- e) the subjects or categories of subjects to whom the personal data may be communicated or who may become aware of it in their capacity as designated representative in the territory of the State, data processors or persons authorised to process personal data.

3. The data subject has the right to obtain:

- a) the updating, rectification or, where interested therein, integration of the data;
- b) the erasure, anonymisation or blocking of data that has been processed unlawfully, including data whose retention is unnecessary for the purposes for which it has been collected or subsequently processed;
- c) certification that the operations referred to in letters a) and b) have been brought to the attention, also as regards their content, of those to whom the data have been communicated or disseminated, except in the case where this proves impossible or involves a use of means manifestly disproportionate to the protected right;
- d) the portability of the data.

4. The data subject has the right to object, in whole or in part:

- a) on legitimate grounds, to the processing of personal data concerning him/her, even if they are relevant to the purpose of the collection;
- b) to the processing of personal data concerning him/her for the purpose of sending advertising or direct sales material or for carrying out market research or commercial communication
