Your personal data will be processed manually, electronically and/or telematically, through the use of cookies (as indicated in the cookie policy available on the website), by means of electronic computers using third-party software and automated contact methods (e.g. automated campaigns for sending emails, SMS, automated telephone contact, instant messaging, social networks, etc.), in compliance with the methods set out in Articles 6 and 32 of the GDPR and through the adoption of the appropriate security measures provided for.

Your data will be processed by appropriately appointed personnel and will be communicated externally to companies acting as independent Data Controllers or Data Processors:

- external parties providing cloud services;
- technical support service providers;
- group companies that provide IT system management services, including server hosting and backup services;
- companies that manage the website, limited to technical access for maintenance and web server management purposes.

Your data is stored within the European Union.

Please note that, in accordance with the principles of lawfulness, purpose limitation and data minimisation, pursuant to Article 5 of the GDPR, the retention period of your personal data is set for a period of time not exceeding the performance of the services provided and, in the case of consent given for marketing purposes, until you decide to cancel your subscription to the service or object to the processing.

EU Regulation 2016/679: Articles 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22 - Rights of the Data Subject

1. The data subject has the right to obtain confirmation of the existence or otherwise of personal data concerning him/her, even if not yet recorded, and

their communication in intelligible form and the possibility of lodging a complaint with the Supervisory Authority

2. The data subject has the right to obtain information on:

a) the origin of the personal data;

b) the purposes and methods of processing;

c) the logic applied in the case of processing carried out with the aid of electronic instruments;

d) the identification details of the data controller, data processors and designated representative pursuant to Article 5, paragraph 2;

e) the subjects or categories of subjects to whom the personal data may be communicated or who may become aware of it in their capacity as designated representative in the territory of the State, data processors or persons authorised to process personal data.

3. The data subject has the right to obtain:

a) the updating, rectification or, where interested therein, integration of the data;

b) the erasure, anonymisation or blocking of data that has been processed unlawfully, including data whose retention is unnecessary for the purposes for which it has been collected or subsequently processed;

c) certification that the operations referred to in letters a) and b) have been brought to the attention, also as regards their content, of those to whom the data have been communicated or disseminated, except in the case where this proves impossible or involves a manifestly disproportionate effort compared to the right being protected;

d) the portability of the data.

4. The data subject has the right to object, in whole or in part:

a) on legitimate grounds, to the processing of personal data concerning him/her, even if relevant to the purpose of the collection;

b) to the processing of personal data concerning him/her for the purpose of sending advertising or direct sales material or for carrying out market research or commercial communication
