COOKIE POLICY

WEBSITE INFORMATION PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 13 OF EUROPEAN REGULATION 2016/679 (GDPR)

Specific summary information is progressively reported or displayed on the pages of the website dedicated to particular services on request that provide forms for data collection. We also inform you that, in order to provide a complete service, our website may contain links to other websites not managed by PA SPA (hereinafter also referred to as PA or Data Controller). PA SPA is not responsible for errors, content, cookies, publication of illegal content, advertising, banners or files that do not comply with current regulations and for compliance with privacy regulations by websites not managed by the Data Controller.

PA SPA, as the Data Controller of your personal data pursuant to and for the purposes of Article 13 of European Regulation 2016/679, hereby informs you that the aforementioned regulation provides for the protection of data subjects with regard to the processing of personal data and that such processing will be based on principles of correctness, lawfulness and transparency and the protection of your privacy and your rights. METHOD OF PROCESSING PERSONAL DATA

Your personal data will be processed manually, electronically and/or telematically, in accordance with the procedures set out in Articles 6 and 32 of the GDPR and by adopting the appropriate security measures provided for.

RECIPIENTS OF PERSONAL DATA AND DISCLOSURE OF DATA

Your data will be processed by appropriately appointed personnel and may be processed by third parties belonging, by way of example, to the following categories:

- external parties providing cloud services;

- technical support service providers;
- group companies providing IT system management services, including server hosting and backup services.

The subjects belonging to the above categories operate, in some cases, as data processors specifically appointed by the Data Controller in accordance with Article 28 of the GDPR, and in other cases in complete autonomy as separate data controllers, it being understood that, in the latter case, the communication of your personal data to these independent data controllers is carried out solely for the purposes indicated in this policy.

DATA CONTROLLER

RIGHTS OF DATA SUBJECTS

EU Regulation 2016/679: Articles 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22 - Rights of the Data Subject

1. The data subject has the right to obtain confirmation of the existence or otherwise of personal data concerning him/her, even if not yet recorded, and its communication in intelligible form and the possibility of lodging a complaint with the Supervisory Authority.

2. The data subject has the right to obtain information on:

- a) the origin of the personal data;
- b) the purposes and methods of processing;
- c) the logic applied in the case of processing carried out with the aid of electronic instruments;
- d) the subjects or categories of subjects to whom the personal data may be communicated or who may become aware of it in their capacity as designated representative in the territory of the State, managers or personnel authorised to process personal data.

3. The data subject has the right to obtain:

- a) the updating, rectification or, when interested, integration of the data;
- b) the cancellation, transformation into anonymous form or blocking of data processed unlawfully, including data whose retention is unnecessary for the purposes for which the data were collected or subsequently processed;
- c) certification that the operations referred to in letters a) and b) have been brought to the attention, also as regards their content, of those to whom the data have been communicated or disseminated, except in the case where this proves impossible or involves a use of means manifestly disproportionate to the protected right;
- d) data portability.

4. The data subject has the right to object, in whole or in part:

- a) on legitimate grounds, to the processing of personal data concerning him/her, even if they are relevant to the purpose of the collection;
- b) to the processing of personal data concerning him/her for the purpose of sending advertising or direct sales material or for carrying out market research or commercial communication.
